With an ever increasing demand for road space and pressure on Town Centre parking, Government and Local Authorities have a responsibility to motivate local populations, including residents, to travel more sustainably.

Poole Quarter is centrally located and therefore offers excellent opportunities for residents and visitors alike to make sustainable choices in respect of their travel patterns.

Poole Quarter provides five different transport modes other than the private motor car. These include:

- 1. The RouteOne Bus Service*
- 2. The Car Club operated by CommonWheels*
- 3. The Carshare scheme operated online by Liftshare*
- 4. Cycling - Secure cycle parking exists for residents and new cycle parking for visitors is due on the site imminently.*
- 5. Walking – There is an excellent level of permeability, connecting Poole Quarter to the Town Centre.*
